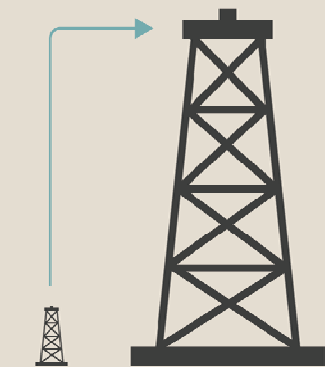


TOGETHER WE CAN DO BETTER, QUINTON

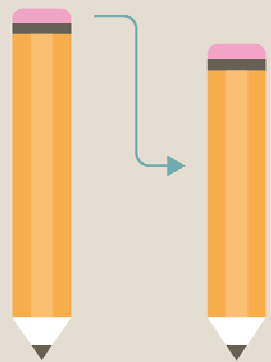

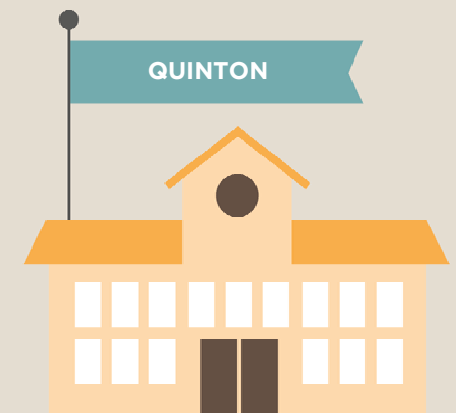
